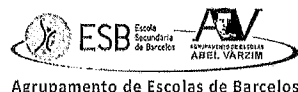




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MINUTES OF THE 2nd LEARNING, TEACHING AND TRAINING ACTIVITIES MEETING

14th- 20th May 2017
BARCELOS / PORTUGAL
ERASMUS+ KA2 project “Power @pp your learning skills“

The 2nd learning, teaching and training activities meeting of the Erasmus + KA2 project “Power @pp your learning skills“ was held from 14th to 20th May 2017 in Barcelos, Portugal.

The Greek delegation from 1st Esperino EPAL of Trikala arrived in Barcelos on 14th May and departed on 20th May 2017.

The delegation was composed by two teachers and two students.

The Hungarian delegation from Mórícz Zsigmond Református Kollégium, Gimnázium, Szakgimnázium és Általános Iskola, arrived in Barcelos on 13th May and departed on 20th May 2017.

The delegation was composed by two teachers and four students.

The Turkish delegation from Yavuz Sultan Selim Mesleki ve Teknik Anadolu Lisesi arrived in Barcelos on 14th May and departed on 20th May 2017.

The delegation was composed by one teacher and two students.

The Spanish delegation from IES Castillo de Luna, arrived in Barcelos on 14th May and departed on 20th May 2017. The delegation was composed by two teachers and two students.

The Italian delegation from Liceo Scientifico M. Curie, arrived in Barcelos on 14th May and departed on 20th May 2017. The delegation was composed by two teachers and two students.

The host organisation of the 2nd learning/teaching and training activities was the Portuguese delegation from Agrupamento de Escolas de Barcelos.

On the 14th May 2017 all the participants of the meeting were welcomed by the Portuguese delegation of the host school Agrupamento de Escolas de Barcelos.

On 15th May 2017, at 09:00, there was a Welcoming Ceremony at the school's Meeting Room which included the School Headmaster's speech, a presentation of the hosting school, an introduction of all the participants of the meeting followed by a guided tour in the school premises.

At 10:30 all the delegations had an official meeting with the Vice-president and representative of the Education and Culture Council at the Town Hall.

At 12:30, all delegations departed by bus to Lisbon where they arrived at 17:30 for a bus sightseeing tour in the city centre: Avenida da Liberdade, Praça do Comércio, Rua da Prata, Parque Eduardo VII.

At 19:00 the delegations went to ISCTE (Instituto Universitário de Lisboa) to participate in the Live TV programme “Prós e Contras”, which celebrated the 30th anniversary of the Erasmus Programme. The



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Talk Show programme was organized to debate the impact on mobility, teaching and learning practices, as well as on young people future jobs. The headmaster of the Agrupamento de Escolas de Barcelos talked about the multicultural experience in the European context and how the mobilities are organized. Several testimonies from the programme guests were shared. He also referred to the project KA2 “Power @pp your learning skills“ which is taking place at the moment in the school he runs, explained what its objectives are and introduced the participant countries.

The Live programme ended at 24:00 and the group returned to Barcelos.

On 16th May, from 14:30 up to 17:30 participant teachers and students attended the Workshop App Design “Study and Conquer” where the Portuguese Application was introduced to all the delegations by the Portuguese students. At first the students explained the use of the App and then they started working on the designing features (drag and drop objects in the screen) of the “Study and Conquer” application. This application deals with homework and aims at revolutionizing its concept as it works as a self-assessment tool. Students get to know their home assignments and by completing the tasks offered by the application they can monitor their progress through quizzes or games. The calculation game “24” aims at developing students’ logical thinking abilities.

On 17th May, at 08:30, the delegations departed for a pleasant cultural guided day trip to Porto. Once the delegations arrived in the amazing Portuguese city, the teachers and students enjoyed a guided tour which started with a visit to the well-known Port Wine Cellars “Offley”, followed by a boat trip on the Douro river. In the afternoon they walked through some of the most important areas in the city: Ribeira, S. Bento Railway Station (considered one of the 14 most beautiful stations by the American magazine Travel+Leisure, due its architecture and the walls covered by blue tiles showing relevant scenes of the Portuguese history), the Mother Church, Sta. Catarina shopping street, Bolhão Market, Lello Bookshop (whose architecture inspired J.K.Rowling for the Harry Potter stories) and other relevant places in the 2nd biggest city of the country.

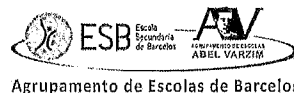
The visit ended up by the Atlantic Ocean.

In the morning of 18th May, all delegations went to IPCA (Instituto Politécnico do Cávado e do Ave), a university institution for a workshop on games designing and programming by the university master student Paulo Amaral. He introduced mainly Unity and Adobe Illustrator as graphic design software. He demonstrated the use of the Visual Studio C# as well.

In the afternoon, the teachers and students attended a Workshop App Programming of “Study and Conquer”. Students tried to rebuild some parts of the application following the steps in the lesson plan and using the blocks of the AppInventor2 environment. Afterwards, some of the Portuguese students showed other examples of Apps they have already designed in their lessons such as “Tooth Adventures” application which aims at creating and maintaining oral hygiene habits in children and young people. The



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students and teachers were given clear instructions on how to run the application. The explanations, given by the Portuguese students, were useful and the application proved to be easy to work with and the students from the invited delegations enjoyed the different choices that the "Tooth Adventures" may offer.

At 18:30 the teachers held a meeting intended to prepare the next meetings. The coordinating team reminded all partners of some points agreed on previous meetings, such as, improving communication among partner schools, using TwinSpace more actively, respecting the deadlines given for each project task and participating more in the newsletters, the website, Facebook page and Google Drive. Regarding the newsletters the dissemination should be established in each school, according to each school's potential readers.

Filling in the EuroPass mobility forms was also reminded.

The Greek coordinating school also reminded the partners to finish the 1st Intercultural activity about national recipes. Besides, the school partners decided to include in a new Padlet the 2nd intercultural activity dealing with two to three national games and toys, which could be achieved by means of presentations, videos or pictures.

The coordinating school also suggested the new deadlines for the application evaluation: the Italian application should be evaluated by the end of September; the Portuguese application should be evaluated by the end of October; the Hungarian application should be evaluated by the end of November.


After this, the Hungarian team introduced some of the possible activities that are going to take place in Hungary with an estimation of expenses.

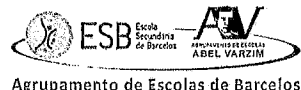
