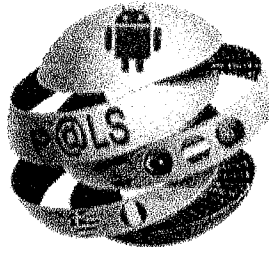


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Minutes of 5th learning, teaching and training activities meeting

of the KA2 Erasmus+ project '**Power @pp Your Learning Skills**' - (P@LS)
2016-1-EL01-KA219-023437

held at Yavuz Sultan Selim Mesleki ve Teknik Anadolu Lisesi in
Osmaniye, Turkey, from 15th to 21st April 2018.

The fifth learning, teaching and training activities meeting of the KA2 Erasmus+ project '**Power @pp Your Learning Skills**' - (P@LS) was held at Yavuz Sultan Selim Mesleki ve Teknik Anadolu Lisesi in Osmaniye, Turkey, from 15th February to 21th April 2018.

The Greek delegation from the 1st Esperino EPAL of Trikala arrived in Osmaniye on the 15th of April and departed on the 21st of April. The delegation was made up of three teachers and two students.

The Hungarian delegation from the M6ricz Zsigmond Reform6tus Koll6gium, Gimn6zium, Szakgimn6zium 6s 6ltal6nos Iskola, in Kis6jsz6ll6s arrived in Osmaniye on the 15th of April and departed on the 21st of April. The delegation was composed by two teachers and three students.

The Spanish delegation from IES Castillo de Luna, in La Puebla de Cazalla arrived in Osmaniye on the 14th of April and departed on the 21st of April. The delegation was made up of two teachers and four students.

The Italian delegation from the Liceo Scientifico M. Curie, in Tradate arrived in Osmaniye on the 15th of April and departed on the 21st of April. The delegation was made up of two teachers and two students.

The Portuguese delegation from the Agrupamento de Escolas de Barcelos, in Barcelos arrived in Osmaniye on the 13th of April and departed on the 22nd of April. The delegation was made up of two teachers and two students.

Yavuz Sultan Selim Mesleki ve Teknik Anadolu Lisesi in Osmaniye was the host organisation of the 5th learning, teaching and training activities meeting. The Portuguese delegation was held on the 13th and the Spanish delegation was welcomed by the host organisation on the 14th of April, and the Greek, the Hungarian and the Italian participants were welcomed on the 15th of April.

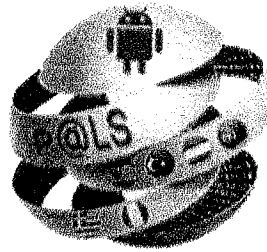
The events of the meeting were organised and realised mostly according to the agenda, which was previously compiled by the host school.

On the 16th of April at 09:00 the Headmaster of Yavuz Sultan Selim Mesleki ve Teknik Anadolu Lisesi, Kadir 6zeli, welcomed all the delegations at school and gave his opening speech and a presentation introducing the school.

At 10:00 the participants left the school to visit the Directorate of the National Education of Osmaniye Province. The directorate manages 424 schools, 6.780 teachers and 125.079 students.

Afterwards, all participants, teachers and students, were taken by mini bus to visit the "Peanut Processing Plant". Here, teachers and students made a snack with the gastronomy of the country and they could socialize with each other.

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At 13:00 all the delegations were taken by mini bus to visit the “Mithat Paşa Primary School”. Arrived here, they were greeted with a beautiful surprise, a traditional dance performed by the children of this school. After that, they were received by the Headmaster and an interchange of questions and answers about how the primary school works.

After lunch, at 15:15 all participants started the project activities, so the App “LifLoS” designed by the Turkish school by means of the App Inventor platform was introduced and worked.

The first steps were explained by Murat Gökçül, the Turkish Coordinator, and the specialized Turkish students were present to give instructions and check how it works. A supporting script was distributed to all participants with the “LifLoS” user view, designing blocking screens and finally all blocks. This application’s main objective was to present the functionalities of the final application developed by the team. The App has three parts. First, there’s a description of the objectives and rules of the various sports as, volleyball, basketball and others. The second part allows the user a quick relation between sports with simulation muscle of the human body. The third part consists of a set of funny games related to different sports games, which can be divided into two different types of games. One of them is a memory matching game with different Physical Education concepts and the second makes the user play with parts of the body that should be placed in a body picture.

After a coffee or tea break, all participants continued to work on the application. All steps were performed without difficulty

On the 17th of April at 9:00 in the second part, the professional program developed by the Turkish team “LifLoS”, was started to be re-built by all participants. Again with scripts in hand, students and teachers spent the time on performing all the necessary steps of "Sports and Muscles".

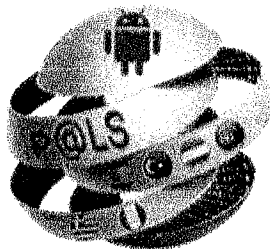
The explanations, given by the ICT teachers and students, were useful.

In the afternoon the groups were taken by bus to visit the City Museum, which portrays the story of Osmaniye, whose main exhibition was a gallery of the tools used in professions, the rugs and natural dyes used in weaving of rugs are also displayed. Finally, we saw a recreation of Osmaniye's occupation after the First World War by the French Army in a diorama and also figures of the Turkish resistance, notably Palalı Süleyman and Rahim Hatun. They visited the ruins of Castabala ancient city (Hierapolis). The site was introduced by the English teacher Şeyma Sultan Kurt. This is located 12 km from the Osmaniye city centre. Castabala has one of the most important ruins of the Ottoman Empire with the avenue with pillars and its amphitheater with five thousand spectator capacity. We visited the Karatepe-Aslantaş National Park. In this park there are traces of the Roman and Byzantine settlements and a castle of the Late Hittite Period. There are also historical artifacts belonging to this period. Finally, we visited the Karatepe Village, famous for handmade ecological carpets and rugs. The rugs woven from goat hair, and the madder dyes used in these rugs are extracted from plants such as walnuts, spurge, mustard, oak and so on.

The day ended with a dinner gently offered by Mr. Yasar Şarici. The members of all the delegations will always be grateful for such a unforgettable and satisfactory evening where frontiers between countries were inexistent and where all of them shared a deep feeling of cultural togetherness. The students had dinner, as usual in the host families' home.

On the 18th of April from 1:00 all participants travelled to Cappadocia for a cultural day trip. During the whole day, they could see some of the most important tourist attractions of the city. All the activities were culturally guided, which helped them to understand such an remarkable place

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protected by the UNESCO. This visit allowed us to enjoy some of the most amazing tourist attractions of the Cappadocia, such as: Pigeon Valley; Uçhisar Castle; Esentepe Panoramic View; Goreme Open Air Museum, Özkonak Underground City, Karamanoğlu Mosque in Ürgüp, the Fairy Chimneys in Ürgüp and Paşabağ Fairy Chimneys. After dinner in Avanos, the delegations came back to Osmaniye.

On the 19th April, all the participants continued the app “LifLoS” using the Blocks Editor to specify event-handlers. After this, the application was installed on the mobile phone to verify that everything works correctly.

At 10:50 to 14:20 there was a teacher’s meeting according to the agenda designed by Mrs. Aikaterini Banteka, their main coordinator. The students went back to their Turkish homes, and after lunch everybody spent some time at “The Fairy Park”, one the main entertaining areas in Osmaniye and they had the chance to socialize.

The topics of discussion were the following:

1. All the Apps will be evaluated before the 8th of June.
2. Every school need to get responses from friendly related schools or institutions to test Apps.
3. Some arrangements of the Greek meeting were presented by our general coordinator, which will be held from 29th until 4th of July.
4. The 4th newsletter will be released in the second week of May, dealing with the Spanish and the Turkish meeting and other topics.
5. All the multicultural activities will be uploaded as a unique video on Facebook and our website in order to assess them during the Greek meeting.
6. All applications will be posted and presented on all the project dissemination web spaces.

On the 20th of April at 08:15, the delegations departed for Gaziantep, a city where it is worth visiting the “Zeugma Mosaic Museum”, maybe one of the best museums in Turkey to watch mosaics. They also learnt about science and the universe formation in the “Gaziantep Planetarium and Science Center”.

After lunch, they had opportunity to visit the “Coppersmith Bazaar”

At 18:00 the delegations came back to Omaniye.

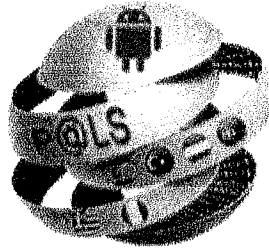

Nothing further to add, these minutes were written and will be signed by all the participating teachers in this 5th Learning, Teaching and Training Activities Meeting.

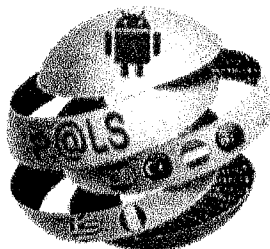
